### **Richard M. Aker, Owner of Aker Plumbing & Heating, Inc. Prosecuted by The Indiana Attorney General's Office** *Richard M. Aker was Not Licensed to do Plumbing work in Indiana*

**Indianapolis, September 11, 2014:** Richard M. Aker, Owner of Aker Plumbing & Heating, Inc., a plumbing contractor based in Portland, IN, has been issued a Letter of Reprimand by the Indiana Plumbing Commission for contracting to perform plumbing work without a license.

The initial complaint alleged that Aker Plumbing was conducting business without being licensed. The Attorney General's Consumer Protection Division completed an investigation and successfully prosecuted an administrative complaint against Richard M. Aker, owner of Aker Plumbing & Heating, Inc., before the Indiana Plumbing Commission.

Under Indiana law, if you are installing, altering, or repairing any plumbing system on a contract basis, you and/or your company must have a Plumbing Contractor License issued by the State of Indiana.
