Commercial Trade Source, Inc. Under Investigation by the Indiana Department of Labor for Alleged Wage and Hour Violations of Labor Law

Indianapolis, July 22, 2015: A claim with the Indiana Department of Labor has been filed alleging violations of Indiana law by Commercial Trade Source, Inc. , an Indianapolis based employer. The claim alleges that an employee was not paid for hours worked and not paid in accordance with the Indiana Common Construction Wage law while working on the IU Kokomo Main Building Project.

The employee was employed by Commercial Trade Source, Inc., a temporary staffing agency and performing pipefitting and plumbing work for Commercial Air Inc. on the IU Kokomo Main Building Project. Commercial Air, Inc., a Lebanon, Indiana-based contractor, performs work for colleges, public schools, and other public entities throughout Central Indiana.

Indiana State Pipe Trades Association Organizer John Kurek stated, "Under state and federal law, workers have protected rights and The Indiana State Pipe Trades Association will fight tirelessly to defend those rights. This is still the United States of America and we still believe in an honest day's pay for an honest day's work."
