# Federal Investigators Find Merit in Charges Filed Against Commercial Air, Inc.

## *Four (4) Charges Allege Violations of Federal Labor Law*

**Indianapolis, January 28, 2014:** The government investigation into allegations of violations of federal law by Commercial Air, Inc. has concluded with federal investigators finding merit in four (4) charges that were filed against the company.

The charges, filed by the Indiana State Pipe Trades Association, have been under investigation by the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) since March 2013 and involve allegations of multiple violations of federal labor law.

Commercial Air, Inc., a Lebanon based contractor, performs work for public school systems throughout Central Indiana. Currently, discussions to reach a settlement agreement are under way. If a settlement agreement cannot be reached with the company, the charges will be slated for trial in front of a NLRB Judge.

Under federal law, employees are free to learn about the benefits of belonging to a union without fear of interference, intimidation, or retaliation from their employer.
