Injunction Filed in Federal Court Against Commercial Air, Inc.

Indianapolis, April 9, 2014: Commercial Air, Inc. was recently put on trial with the National Labor Relations Board for five (5) charges which were filed against the company. The National Labor Relations Board has also filed a petition with the Federal District Court seeking a temporary injunction against Commercial Air, Inc. to stop the alleged unfair labor practices while the case is under consideration by the administrative law judge.

The charges, filed by the Indiana State Pipe Trades Association, have been under investigation by the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) since March 2013 and involve allegations of multiple violations of federal labor law.

Commercial Air, Inc., a Lebanon, Indiana based contractor, performs work for public schools and other public entities throughout Central Indiana.

Indiana State Pipe Trades Association Organizer John Kurek stated, "Under federal law, employees are free to learn about the benefits of belonging to a union without the fear of interference, intimidation, or retaliation from their employer. "
