## IOSHA Cites Midwest Constructors, LLC for Safety Violations at Drury Inn

*Midwest Constructors Receives \$4,400 in Proposed Penalties*

**Indianapolis, June 10, 2015:** The Indiana Occupational Safety and Health Administration (IOSHA) has issued a Safety Order and Notification of Penalty report on Midwest Constructors, LLC of Indianapolis. The order lists four (4) serious violations and \$4,400 in proposed penalties.

The violations occurred at the job site of the new Drury Inn hotel at Meridian and 96<sup>th</sup> Street on the Northside of Indianapolis. Among the violations cited were not providing drainage or spillage controls on a 100 gallon diesel fuel tank, not protecting the diesel fuel tank from collision damage, not instructing employees in the recognition and avoidance of unsafe conditions of diesel fuel tank hazards, and failing to identify existing and predictable hazards and/or take necessary measures to alleviate the hazards of the diesel fuel tank.

Midwest Constructors is slated to be one of the major contractors on the new \$121 million Market Square Tower Flaherty & Collins Properties project in downtown Indianapolis. The high-profile project will include luxury apartments and a Whole Foods Market.

There is no word on whether IOSHA will be actively monitoring the Market Square Tower project when it gets fully under way.
