Nine Federal Charges Now Pending Against Midwest Constructors, LLC

Federal Investigation Expands Again to Include New Charges

Indianapolis, April 23, 2015: The current investigation into allegations of violations of federal labor law by Midwest Constructors, LLC, a local construction contractor, has expanded once again. There are now nine (9) charges pending against Midwest and under federal investigation.

The most recent charges, filed on April 8, allege members of Midwest management once again engaged in illegal surveillance as well as other activities which violated the federally protected rights of its employees.

The new allegations and charges are among a string of multiple allegations and charges currently being investigated by federal agents of the National Labor Relations Board. At this point, it is not known how long the investigation may take to be completed.

According to the Midwest Constructors, LLC's web site, it is slated to be one of the major contractors on the new Market Square Tower project. The Market Square Tower project is a Flaherty & Collins Properties project in downtown Indianapolis. The ground breaking for that project took place on February 18, 2015. The high-profile project will include luxury apartments and a Whole Foods Market.
