## Midwest Constructors Being Investigated by IOSHA for Alleged Safety Violations

*Alleged Violations Occurred at New Drury Inn Job Site*

**Indianapolis, March 5, 2015:** The Indiana Occupational Safety and Health Administration (IOSHA) is currently investigating a complaint filed against Midwest Constructors, LLC of Indianapolis.

The alleged violations occurred at the job site of the new Drury Inn hotel at Meridian and 96<sup>th</sup> Street on the Northside of Indianapolis. Among the allegations being investigated are serious issues surrounding worker fall protection. The Drury Inn is a multi-story hotel.

Midwest Constructors is slated to be one of the major contractors on the new \$121 million Market Square Tower Flaherty & Collins Properties project in downtown Indianapolis. The ground breaking for that project took place on February 18. The high-profile project will include luxury apartments and a Whole Foods Market.

There is no word on whether IOSHA will be actively monitoring the Market Square Tower project when it get fully under way.
