# More Legal Woes for Midwest Constructors, LLC

## *Federal Investigation Finds Merit in Nine (9) Charges Filed Against Midwest Constructors*

**Indianapolis, August 15, 2015:** The National Labor Relations Board, the federal agency investigating alleged violations of federal labor law by Midwest Constructors, has found merit in nine (9) of the charges filed with that agency.

Among the charges filed were numerous allegations that members of Midwest management violated federal labor law in a variety of ways which negatively impacted the federally protected rights of its employees.

Midwest may now choose to attempt to reach a settlement agreement with the National Labor Relations Board, or if they decline to engage in settlements talks, the cases will be scheduled for trial. Attempts to reach a settlement agreement can sometimes take as long as 30-days. There is no word yet on whether Midwest will attempt a settlement agreement.
