## **Another Federal Charge Filed Against TSW Utility Solutions, Inc.**

*Seven Charges Now Under Review by Federal Investigators*

**Indianapolis, September 26, 2013:** The government investigation into allegations of violations of federal law by TSW Utility Solutions, Inc. now includes another charge. The charge, filed by the Laborers Union on August 29, brings the total number of charges currently under review by federal investigators to seven (7) and alleges further illegal conduct on the part TSW management.

The new charge, filed with the National Labor Relations Board in Indianapolis, alleges TSW management again took photographs and engaged in surveillance of federally protected organizing activities. The charges arise from on-going organizing campaign with TSW with all of the allegations occurring on a water pipeline project in Greenwood, Indiana.

TSW Utility Solutions, Inc. is a locally-owned construction contractor who performs work for local utility companies. Federal investigators are proceeding with the investigation into the allegations, but it is unclear how long the investigation may take to be completed.

Under federal law, employees are free to talk with Union Organizers on non-work time in non-work areas without interference or intimidation from employers or their management representatives. This ensures that employees are free to learn about the benefits of belonging to a union without undue influence from their employers.
