Federal Investigators Find Merit in Charges Filed Against TSW Utility Solutions, Inc.

Six (6) Charges Against Company Found to Have Merit

Indianapolis, December 9, 2013: The government investigation into allegations of violations of federal law by TSW Utility Solutions, Inc. has concluded with federal investigators finding merit in six (6) of the seven (7) charges which were filed against the company. The seventh charge was voluntarily withdrawn by the union.

The charges, filed by the Laborers Union, have been under investigation by the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) since August and involve allegations of multiple violations of federal labor law.

TSW Utility Solutions, Inc., an Indianapolis-based VBE contractor, performs work for local utility companies throughout Central Indiana. Currently, discussions to reach a settlement agreement are under way. If a settlement agreement cannot be reached with the company, the charges will be slated for trial in front of a NLRB Judge.

Under federal law, employees are free to talk with Union Organizers on non-work time in non-work areas without interference or intimidation from employers or their management representatives. This ensures that employees are free to learn about the benefits of belonging to a union without undue influence from their employers.
