Additional Federal Charges Filed Against TSW Utility Solutions, Inc.

Federal Investigation Proceeds into Allegations of Violations of Federal Labor Law Standards

Indianapolis, August 29, 2013: Less than a week after the Laborers Union filed four (4) Unfair Labor Practice (ULP) charges with the National Labor Relations Board (NLRB) against TSW Utility Solutions, Inc., the Laborers Union has filed two (2) more charges alleging additional illegal conduct on the part of the employer.

The two new charges, also filed with NLRB, Region 25, allege that TSW management again surveilled and called the police on Union Organizers for attempting to talk with employees about the benefits of being union members. The charges arise from an on-going organizing campaign with the company. The Vice President of the company, Jess Testerman, is named in the charges as the company representative.

Federal investigators are just beginning the investigation into the charges filed last week. With the two new allegations, it is unclear how long the investigation may take to be completed.

Under federal law, employees are free to talk with Union Organizers on non-work time in non-work areas without interference or intimidation from employers or their management representatives. This ensures that employees are free to learn about the benefits of belonging to a union without undue influence from their employers.

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
